The Details:

We park our cars at the bottom of the tubing adventure. Once everyone is checked in and has a tube, a bus will drive us to the top of the adventure and drop us off (~10 am). We float to the bottom, where our cars are waiting for us. Children >3 are welcome. Children <14 must wear a life jacket

Food: Half way down the river trip, there is a stand that sells hotdogs and hamburgers and nachos and vegetarian options. They even accept soggy dollars or credit card! There are picnic tables there and you can order food from the hotdog man, or you can bring your own lunch. Just remember to put it in a water-proof container!



Costs:

Current cost is \$46 per person

If we can get 20 people together, we can get group pricing for \$36 per person.

Unless we get a group of 20 people together, everyone will be responsible for getting their own tickets.
