Peter David Schindler M.D., age 93, husband of the late Marianne G. (Leber) Schindler, of Kennett Square, Pennsylvania, passed away peacefully on Wednesday, May 15, 2024, in Kendal at Longwood. Born on January 12, 1931, in Berlin, Germany, he was the son of the late Lotti (Sonntag) and George Schindler.

Peter immigrated to the United States with his family at the age of 5 years old. He honorably served in the United States Army before receiving his Bachelor of Arts degree from Lafayette College. Peter later returned to Switzerland and obtained his medical degree. While in Switzerland, he met Marianne, and it was love at first sight, which led to their marriage on March 21, 1959, in Zurich. Peter and Marianne later moved to the United States, where Peter would complete his residency.

Peter's devotion to helping people as a Child, Adolescent, and Family Psychiatrist was unparalleled. His appreciation for nature and time spent outdoors was evident in his love for sailing on the Chesapeake and around Nantucket Island.
